Hatch costs

Maximum out-of-pocket: \$990* includes

- All your antenatal and postnatal visits
- Pregnancy Management Fee (PMF)
- Delivery fee (including Caesarean birth) at Mater Mothers' Private Brisbane

Please note the PMF is paid at 28 weeks and your appointments are not paid in advance - they are paid following each individual visit

*\$0 out-of-pocket if you are a member of one of our partnered health funds

Other costs

- Hospital excess (check with your health fund) payable once in a calendar year
- Private anaesthetist, if required
- Private paediatrician
- Mater Mothers' Bundle of Joy card priced at \$490. This card includes
 routine blood tests, two routine ultrasounds, hospital car parking for
 four days after the birth of your baby, partner meals for up to four days
 during your hospital stay, plus other exclusive offers and discounts.
- Visits to the Pregnancy Assessment Centre

- Other specialist fees (only if requiring medical referral)
- Antenatal education classes enjoy a 20 per cent discount on parenting classes at Mater Mothers thanks to your Bundle of Joy card.

If you have private health insurance with top pregnancy cover with one of our partnered health funds, then you may be eligible for zero out-of-pocket costs with Hatch.

These are out-of-pocket fees and only available to women who are Medicare eligible and privately insured with pregnancy cover. Additional fees will only apply if you are privately insured with certain health funds. Contact Hatch for more information.
